

Kindergarten Math Standards

Number Sequence

- I can count to 100 by 1s and 10s.
- I can write numbers to 20.

Counting Objects

- I can count and write the number of objects in a set up to 20.
- I can count objects up to 20.

Comparing Quantities

- I can compare the amounts of two sets with less than 10 objects in each.
- I can compare written numbers from 1-10.

Decomposing Numbers

- I can decompose numbers 1-10 into two groups of smaller numbers.
- I can show that any number 1-10 can be created using a variety of addends.
- I can decompose numbers 11-19 into one group of ten and some ones.

Addition

- I can solve “add to” addition problems in the range 1-10.
- I can solve “put together” addition problems in the range 1-10.
- I can find the number that, when added to a number, results in a total of 10.

Subtraction

- I can solve “take from” subtraction problems in the range 1-10.
- I can solve “take apart” subtraction problems in the range 1-10.

Measurement

- I can describe the measurable attributes of an object.
- I can compare the measurable attributes of two objects.

Geometric Figures

- I can compare two-dimensional shapes by their geometric attributes.
- I can compare three-dimensional shapes by their geometric attributes.
- I can describe objects in the environment using shape names

Constructing Geometric Figures

- I can combine simple shapes to form larger shapes or images.
- I can model shapes around me by drawing or building them.

Categorical Data

- I can sort a set of objects into categories.
